## PUBLIC USE REGULATIONS PATAGONIA AZUL

- $\cdot$  Only ride on trails or areas indicated for public use.
- $\cdot$  Drive with caution and respect speed limits.
- · Park only in authorized places.

 $\cdot$  Do not feed or approach wildlife. There may be presence of potentially dangerous animals.

 $\cdot$  No pets are allowed in the park.

 $\cdot$  Take care of the archeological heritage. Do not extract minerals, rocks, shells or other material

 $\cdot$  Hunting and fishing is forbidden, as well as collecting seaweeds, mollusks or octopus.

- $\cdot$  It is forbidden to extract firewood. Ask the host for firewood, if available.
- $\cdot$  Swimming in the ocean is not allowed. There are no lifeguards on site.

 $\cdot$  Keep volume levels low and avoid all disturbing noises. Do not use loudspeakers.

 $\cdot$  Visitors should take with them any waste produced during their stay.

 $\cdot$  It is not allowed to throw or bury toilet paper in the area. Use the dry toilets, following the indications.

 $\cdot$  We recommend the use of sunscreen, a hat, sunglasses and appropriate footwear.

- $\cdot$  Do not forget to bring water for the trails.
- $\cdot$  There is no landline or cell phone signal in the area.

## Overnight

- $\cdot$  Only camp in permitted areas.
- $\cdot$  The Portal does not have specific services for campers.

 $\cdot$  It is forbidden to make fire, except in the campfires. Make sure that the fire is completely extinguished before leaving.

 $\cdot$  Use the designated areas for washing dishes and personal items.

 $\cdot$  Respect the staff's private areas.

 $\cdot$  After 11 p.m., silence is requested to respect the rest hours of other visitors and the staff living in the Portal.
