

PUBLIC USE REGULATIONS

PATAGONIA AZUL

- Only ride on trails or areas indicated for public use.
- Drive with caution and respect speed limits.
- Park only in authorized places.
- Do not feed or approach wildlife. There may be presence of potentially dangerous animals.
- No pets are allowed in the park.
- Take care of the archeological heritage. Do not extract minerals, rocks, shells or other material
- Hunting and fishing is forbidden, as well as collecting seaweeds, mollusks or octopus.
- It is forbidden to extract firewood. Ask the host for firewood, if available.
- Swimming in the ocean is not allowed. There are no lifeguards on site.
- Keep volume levels low and avoid all disturbing noises. Do not use loudspeakers.
- Visitors should take with them any waste produced during their stay.
- It is not allowed to throw or bury toilet paper in the area. Use the dry toilets, following the indications.
- We recommend the use of sunscreen, a hat, sunglasses and appropriate footwear.
- Do not forget to bring water for the trails.
- There is no landline or cell phone signal in the area.

Overnight

- Only camp in permitted areas.
- The Portal does not have specific services for campers.

- It is forbidden to make fire, except in the campfires. Make sure that the fire is completely extinguished before leaving.
- Use the designated areas for washing dishes and personal items.
- Respect the staff's private areas.
- After 11 p.m., silence is requested to respect the rest hours of other visitors and the staff living in the Portal.
