

## **PUBLIC USE REGULATIONS**

### **PATAGONIA**

- Only ride on trails or areas indicated for public use.
- Drive with caution and respect speed limits.
- Only park in authorized places.
- Do not feed or approach wildlife. Potentially dangerous animals are present.
- The entry and stay of pets in the park is prohibited.
- Take care of the archeological heritage: It is forbidden to extract minerals and rocks.
- It is forbidden to cut branches from the trees to make firewood.
- Hunting and fishing are forbidden.
- Keep volume levels low and avoid all disturbing noises. Do not use loudspeakers.
- It is not allowed to throw or bury toilet paper in the area. Use the dry toilets, following the indications.
- Visitors should take with them any waste produced during their stay.
- We recommend using sunscreen, a hat, sunglasses, and appropriate footwear.
- Do not forget to bring water for the trails.
- There is no landline or cell phone signal in the area.

#### **Overnight**

- Only camp in permitted areas.
- The portal does not have specific services for campers.
- It is forbidden to make fire, except in the campfires. Make sure that the fire is completely extinguished before leaving.
- To wash dishes and personal items, use the designated areas.
- Respect the rules of coexistence.

- Respect the staff's private areas.
- After 11 p.m., silence is requested to respect the rest hours of other visitors and the staff living in the portal.
